

## Voice-over General Rates

\*pricing subject to change according to specific catagories, these rates of just a general idea. These are non-union rates.

## **Definitions**

- **Buy-Out:** A flat rate that secures the right to use your voice. All non-union jobs operate on a "buy-out" basis.
- Monthly Retainer: An agreement where the client pays a fixed monthly fee to Saintiny
  Voices for ongoing services. The rate is based on the average monthly workload. Saintiny
  Voices will establish a maximum amount of work the client can request each month under
  this rate.
- **Per Hour:** charging an hourly rate based on the length of time **Saintiny Voices** spends at the studio.
- Per Project: charging a flat rate for a script, regardless of the time spent at the studio.
- **Per Session:** charging a flat rate for the recording session (the time **Saintiny Voices** spend in the studio) regardless of the number of projects recorded.
- **Per Spot:** charging a flat rate for each commercial spot, regardless of the time spent at the studio.
- **Scratch Track:** a temporary recording that is a "place-holder" for the final voice-over. Not recorded as "broadcast quality" sound. Production facilities use scratch tracks to assist them with designing TV/video/flash presentations.
- Session: the time spent at a Saintiny Voices recording studio on one given trip. If
   Saintiny Voices leave the studio and come back on a different day, even if Saintiny
   Voices continue to work on the same project, it is a new "session."

## Animation, Cartoon, Videogame

This category covers "pre-lay" recording, meaning we are voicing characters before they are animated.

#### Rates

- Broadcast (Saturday morning cartoons, Nickelodeon, etc.) \$250 per hour
- Non-Broadcast (talking toys, interactive CD-ROMs, Internet, etc.) \$185 per hour

#### **Notes**

- Lower rates for animation produced overseas.
- Rates may vary by TV station or by client.
- If a show is sold to another station, we will receive an additional buy-out (because the usage has changed/been extended

#### **Audiobook**

Audiobook recording rates are typically computed by "per completed hour."

#### **Non-Union Narration Rates**

- Inexperienced narrator \$85 per completed hour
- Moderately Experienced \$100 per completed hour
- Very Experienced \$250-\$500 per completed hour
- Per RAW hr \$225/hr No editing at all RAW Narrations only

## **Editing Rates**

• \$75- 125 per working hour of editing time

## **Hybrid Agreement**

• \$100 per finish hour plus royalty share

## Corporate, Industrial, Training Video

## "Per Project" Rates by length of script

- 0-5 Minutes \$140
- 5-10 Minutes \$180
- 10-20 Minutes \$240
- 20-30 Minutes \$320
- Longer add \$140 for every 10 additional minutes

#### "Per Hour" Rates

\$275

## Notes Per hour charges

- Set as 1-hour minimum.
- after the first hour, 1/4-hour increments charges apply.
- Discount available after the first hour (e.g. \$275 for the 1st hour, \$150 for every hour after that)
- Lower "Bulk rate" charge available for specific scripts on on-going projects

#### **Dubbing**

Dubbing occurs in both animation and live-action projects and requires Saintiny Voices to match pre-recorded/pre-animated mouth movements.

#### Rates

- Broadcast (anime, movies, etc.): \$160 per hour
- Non-Broadcast (Internet): \$120 per hour

#### **Notes**

Animation dubbing involves replacing the original language with English (or replacing English with another language for a foreign market).

There are multiple applications for live-action dubbing:

- replacing the original voice
- fixing lines when the live audio is faulty

## **Dubbing (continued)**

- "cleaning up" language for a TV broadcast of a film (if the original actor is unavailable a "sound-alike" will be hired)
- providing background "murmur" for crowd scenes

## eLearning, ESL, How-To-Video, Tutorial

#### Per Hour" Rates

• \$250

#### Notes

- Set as 1-hour minimum.
- After the first hour, 1/4-hour increments charges apply.
- Discount available after the first hour (e.g. \$250 for the 1st hour, \$150 for every hour after that)
- Lower "Bulk rate" charge available for specific scripts on on-going projects

## **Documentary, Film**

Moderate-Play/Non-Broadcast Narrations (Documentary on local PBS affiliate only, etc.)

Per Hour: \$200

Per Project: \$300 and up, based on length of script \*

Large-Play/Broadcast Narrations (National Geographic documentary, etc.)

Per Hour: \$300

Per Project: \$500 and up, based on length of script \*

## **Notes**

#### Per hour rate:

- Set as 1-hour minimum.
- After the first hour, 1/4-hour increments charges apply.
- Discount available after the first hour (e.g. \$250 for the 1st hour, \$150 for every hour after that)
- Lower "Bulk rate" charge available for specific scripts on on-going projects

## Medical, Pharmaceutical

Medical narration is a "special skill" which Saintiny Voices have the voices for this skill.

## "Per Project" Rates by length of script

- 0-5 Minutes \$180
- 5-10 Minutes \$220
- 10-20 Minutes \$325
- 20-30 Minutes \$440
- Longer add \$150 for every 10 additional minutes

### "Per Hour" Rates

• \$350

#### Notes

Offer copy-writing services to your medical clients (\$100 per hour)

#### Per hour rate:

- Set as 1-hour minimum.
- After the first hour, 1/4-hour increments charges apply.
- Discount available after the first hour (e.g. \$250 for the 1st hour, \$150 for every hour after that)
- Lower "Bulk rate" charge available for specific scripts on on-going projects

## **Podcast**

## "Per Project" Rates by length of script

- 0-5 Minutes \$50 to \$150
- 5-10 Minutes \$75 to \$200
- 10-20 Minutes \$100 to \$250
- 20-30 Minutes \$220 to \$300

#### "Per Hour" Rates

• \$150 to \$300

## **Podcast (continued)**

**Notes:** Rates vary GREATLY, on factors as diverse as contribution to the broadcast, time on air, broad or narrow band of the broadcast, sponsorships, etc. As always, it's strictly a negotiable issue and usually depends on whether it's a single read, a regular contribution or a simple spot. Per hour rate:

- Set as 1-hour minimum.
- After the first hour, 1/4-hour increments charges apply.
- Discount available after the first hour (e.g. \$250 for the 1st hour, \$150 for every hour after that).
- Lower "Bulk rate" charge available for specific scripts on on-going projects.

## Promo, Trailer, Imaging

Rates are per spot.

#### Radio

- Local Promo/ Station Imaging \$150 to \$200
- Regional Promo/ Station Imaging \$250 to \$500
- National Promo/ Station Imaging \$300 to \$750
- For on-going Station Imaging (Saintiny Voices are "the voice" of the station) Custom Retainer\*

#### **Television**

- Local Promo \$120 to \$200
- Regional Promo \$220 to \$500
- National Promo \$550 to \$1,000

On-going Station Imaging (Saintiny Voices are "the voice" of the station) - Custom Retainer\*

#### Trailers (Radio and TV)

- Local/Small Market play \$175 to \$300
- Regional/Medium Market play \$325 to \$500
- National/Large Market play \$1,000 to \$2,000

## **Promo, Trailer, Imaging (continued)**

#### Notes

Saintiny Voices will be paid separately for each spot.

\* Custom Retainer: When Saintiny Voices is being hired to be "the voice" of a station, meaning the client will record promos or imaging spots on a consistent, on-going basis. In this situation, Saintiny Voices will negotiate a monthly retainer based on the average amount of work. The client will pay a lump sum per month rather than per individual job. The maximum number of spots will be three (3) at the negotiated retainer rate.

### **Small Exhibit at a Small Museum**

• Per Hour: \$150

Per Project: \$200 and up, based on length of script \*

## Major Exhibit at a Major Museum

• Per Hour: \$350

Per Project: \$500 and up, based on length of script \*

#### Notes

#### Per hour rate:

- Set as 1-hour minimum.
- After the first hour, 1/4-hour increments charges apply.
- Discount available after the first hour (e.g. \$250 for the 1st hour, \$150 for every hour after that)

## Telephony, IVR, On-hold, Menu-prompt

#### Rates

- Per Word \$.25 per word
- Per Prompt \$5 per prompt
- Per Hour \$100 to \$150
- Per Project Custom rate
- Monthly Retainer Custom rate

## Telephony, IVR, On-hold, Menu-prompt (continued)

**Notes** 

**Per Project:** This rate is determined by the length of the script, as some Telephony projects are simple (welcome message + a few prompts) and some are very involved (voicemail prompts for main menu, sub-menus, sub-sub-meus, . . . ). In many cases Saintiny Voices charges a "project" rate for the initial recording, and then charge per word, per prompt, or per hour for updates.

**Monthly Retainer:** If Saintiny Voices is hired to be "the voice" of a company, meaning that you will record for their telephony system on a consistent, on-going basis. In this situation Saintiny Voices will negotiate a monthly retainer based on the average amount of work. The client will pay Saintiny Voices a lump sum per month rather than per individual job. Maximum number of spots recorded will be five (5) at the negotiate retainer rate.

#### **Television**

Rates are per spot.

#### Local

- Small Market (e.g. one town in San Antonio) \$225
- Large Market (e.g. Boston or New York City) \$400

#### Regional

• \$650 to \$750

#### **National**

• \$1,500 to \$2,000 or standard Union rates

### Tags (5-10 Seconds) \*

- Local \$75 to \$100
- Regional \$100 to \$250
- National \$300 to \$400
- \* Note: The payment for one tag is included with the payment for the spot. Saintiny Voices will be requested to record multiple tags along with the one spot. Saintiny Voices will be paid "per tag" for all additional tags. This will be clarified with the client prior to recording.

## **Television (continued)**

### Notes

- If Saintiny Voices records multiple spots in one session Saintiny Voices will be paid separately for each spot.
- Rates through subscription audition sites may vary significantly.
- Discount available for a series of spots.
- Offering scratch tracks for free or for a heavily discounted rate.
- An "unlimited buy-out" available.
